School attendance and absence is high on the Governments agenda, therefore it is a priority for us. We understand that some mornings don't go as planned but persistent lateness needs to be addressed. Please aim to arrive at school on time, school starts at 8.40 a.m. and a member of staff is available in the playground from 8.30 a.m. If you have any concerns please speak with us.

If children arrive in school after the gates have been locked at 8.45 a.m. they must report to main reception, if as a parent, you are leaving the school site and let children through please remind them to go to reception door – thank you.

During registration 8.40 - 8.55 vital interventions occur, children also have the opportunity to practice spellings for the weekly spelling tests, improve handwriting skills, practice timetables and maths skills and read. Where children are persistently late they will be required to carry out this work later during the school day so that they do not fall behind in their learning.

A reminder that if your child is ill and unable to attend school please contact the school by telephone, 01594 822171, an answer phone is available. Please do not send an email as these may not be picked up until later in the school day.


School Census Day – Hot School Meals – Thursday 5th October 2023

5th October is the national schools census day. School funding for the next financial year (April – March) is based on number of children registered at school on this day, also numbers who are on the SEND register, free school meals register and even those who eat a school meal on this day. So as to maximise the amount of funding we can receive we will hold a special meal on the Thursday and encourage everyone to try a hot school meal.

Thursday's Menu will be:

Hot dog or Vegetarian Hotdog with Chips Coleslaw and Salad and Syrup Sponge and Custard for pudding.

The weekly menu slips will reflect these changes. Please ensure menu slips are handed in during registration on a Monday morning. A hot meal costs £2.54 daily £12.70 weekly, (Pre-school £2.55 daily £12.75 weekly) and should be paid for in advance through our online payment system www.parentpay.com. Those children who are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 are entitled to a free meal under the Universal infant free school meal scheme, as are those entitled to free school meals.
