On the second day of Christmas my true love sent to me: 2 turtle doves and 1 partridge in a pear tree	2+1 = 3 presents on day 2	1+3= 4
On the third day of Christmas my true love sent to me: 3 French hens, 2 turtle doves and 1 partridge in a pear tree	3+2+1=6 presents on day 3	6+4= 10

On the fourth day of Christmas my true love sent to me: 4 calling birds, 3 French hens, 2 turtle doves and 1 partridge in a pear tree
