We are currently collecting these vouchers so that we can gain additional free equipment for the school.

#### **Free School Meals**

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following: -

Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, income-related Employment and Support Allowance, support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, the guaranteed element of Pension Credit, Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190), Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit Universal Credit.

The school also gets a premium of £1,320 for each child entitled to free school meals. This is used to provide additional support and resources for the children.

#### **School Meals**

We have been advised that our catering contractor, Caterlink, will be increasing the price of a school meal to £2.28 per day, £11.40 per week from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2017. Parent Pay will be automatically updated.

#### **Reminders**

To help the school run efficiently and keep our children safe please can parents / carers remember:

- To update contact details when they change ie phone numbers, addresses etc.
- Let us know if someone other than the usual is collecting your child from school.
- Collect children promptly at 3.00 or telephone the school if you know you are going to be late.
- Not park in the school playground or staff car park unless permission has been granted by the Head Teacher
- Not to bring dogs on the school premises we are currently having issues with dog mess on the playground.
- Not to bring children onto the school site before 8.30 a.m. A member of staff will be on duty each day in the rear playground from this time.
- Not let children play on the outside equipment before or after school.
- Not walk through the school unless accompanied by a member of staff.

#### **Attendance and Holidays in Term Time**

Firstly a big thank you to our children and families for ensuring that attendance up to the end of term 3 has remained high at 96.5%, which is the Governors target figure. Currently 68% of our children are above this target and 18 children have 100% attendance.

We continue to implement the Government rules around holidays in term time. The 'Education (Pupil Registration) (England) Regulations 2006' amendments remove the ability for head teachers to grant holidays or extended leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. Regular and punctual attendance at school is fundamental to ensure that children receive the very best possible educational provision in order that they may secure their best possible outcomes. If you chose to remove your child from school for a holiday or other absence you must put your request in writing to the head teacher. All requests will be reviewed on an individual basis.

#### **Communication with parents**

Good communication with parents is essential to the smooth running of the school. You may have noticed that letters sent out this term have also been emailed to parents where we have up to date email addresses. All letters are also available on the parent app (if you have downloaded it), on the school website, and in the folder outside the office door, and the oldest child per family is given a paper copy.
