Please find enclosed the contact details we hold in school about your child and the privacy notice which details how we use this information. We ask that you check the details and return to school in an envelope as soon as possible.

We use the details of the 'priority 1' contacts and anyone with parental responsibility for our email and text systems. If you have not received a text or email from us this term we do not hold the correct information for you. Emails and texts will be sent from our website provider 'eschools' and may go directly to your spam or junk folder, please check and make 'eschools' a trusted sender.

Following feedback from parents we have decided that as from January 2018 we will no longer send home paper copies of letters, unless you request them below. However if a response is required from you we will issue a paper copy initially.

We are also relaunching the Parent App, this is an app similar to facebook messenger, whatsapp etc. It can be downloaded on an iphone or android phone through Apple App Store (iPhone) or Google Play (Android).

Each parent has a login and password, detailed below, and you will be able to see your child's attendance, all emails and texts, and eventually you will be able to book your own parents evening appointments. School information is held in one place rather than trawling through your personal texts and emails.
