Nursery Provision in Littledean

Following many months of uncertainty Little Acorns Nursery have decided to close on 7th April 2017. We understand that the last day for children is Wednesday 5th April 2017.

The Governors strongly believe that a pre-school provision is needed in the village so have decided to extend our scope and open a Pre-School Class. Although a lot work will be required behind the scenes we have strict processes to recruit staff and set up the provision; we hope that it will be a fairly seamless transition for the children (and parents) currently attending the Nursery. It is hoped that we will be able to open the Pre-School late April / Early May, from 8.45 – 11.45 Monday – Friday, term time only initially. We hope at some point in the near future to be able to open from 8.45 – 3.00 each day.
