Dear Parents and Carers,

I am a PGCE student/trainee teacher and will be undertaking a placement in your child's class throughout the spring term, taking increasing responsibility for leading the teaching and learning.

As part of my course, I will be undertaking a small research study, focusing on the development of an aspect of my practice as a teacher. The aim of the research is to enable me to understand the impact of my teaching on the children's learning and to improve my teaching. The aspect of my teaching I have chosen to focus on is my use of effective questioning. The children's learning and welfare will be paramount throughout and no child will be unfairly advantaged or disadvantaged as a result of the project.

For the purposes of the research study, in order to understand the impact of my teaching on the children's progress, I will be gathering some evidence related to the children's learning.
