What are the prime numbers to 20?


Key vocabulary

Composite number – a whole number which is not prime. It has at least one divisor that is not 1 or itself.

Factor – a number which multiplies with another to make a product.

Multiple – the result of multiplying a number by an integer.

Prime Number – a number with only two factors.
