Free School Meal Vouchers

The families entitled to free school meals should have now received notification that you have a £15 voucher per week per child to redeem to enable you purchase food for your child. The next batch of vouchers for the two weeks before half term should start to arrive early next week. If you have not received an email please check your spam / junk folder. The school will continue to provide vouchers for free school meals after the February half term holiday. Any problems please do not hesitate to contact the school.

As part of the 'No child goes hungry' campaign Gloucestershire County Council will be providing vouchers to the value of £15 per week per child for the February half term. If you have previously received vouchers during the October holiday or Christmas holiday you will be sent the vouchers automatically. If you have not requested vouchers before or have changed your email address please apply by completing the online form:

Covid – 19 Reporting

The school has to complete a daily report to the Department for Education detailing who is in school and who is absent due to either suspected Covid – 19 symptoms; high temperature, cough, loss of sense of smell or taste, or a positive Covid – 19 test. If your children have either of these please report to school by email, so that we can firstly support you and secondly report to the DFE. Many thanks.

Healthy Start Voucher Scheme

Vitamins are now available FREE in Gloucestershire as part of the Healthy Start voucher scheme, helping to give children the best start in life. If someone is pregnant or has a child under 4 and they are getting benefits, they may be able to get Healthy Start vouchers to help buy some basic foods and vitamins. They will also qualify if they are under 18 and pregnant, even if they don't get any benefits. Pregnant women and children over 1 and under 4 can get one £3.10 voucher per week. Children under 1 can get two £3.10 vouchers (£6.20) per week. The Healthy Start scheme provides vouchers to spend with local retailers and also gives people access to free vitamins distributed via the Children and Families Hub from Shire Hall. Scams
