Changes to weather and daylight during the seasons						
Spring Daylight: 13 hours	Early spring can be cold and the lowest temperatures of the year can be in March, it might even snow! Temperatures gradually get warm- er though as summer approaches.	Winter Daylight: 8 hours	Temperatures are very cold. The weather is very wet, windy and cloudy at the start. Towards the end of winter, the weather be- comes colder and drier.			
Summer Daylight: 16 hours	The warmest and sunniest season! Thunderstorms happen more often if it gets very hot.	Autumn Daylight: 12 hours	Temperatures get cooler the closer winter approaches. The weather is very changeable.
