#### **Absences from School**

A reminder that school starts at 8.40 a.m. Gates are locked at 8.45 a.m. If children arrive after this they must report to the main reception doors for entry into school and will be marked as late on the register.

If your child is going to be absent then please contact the school office by 9.15am to advise why they will not be attending.

School ends at 3.10 p.m. or 4.10 p.m. when attending after school clubs. If you are going to be late or if someone different is due to collect your child, please let us know. Thank you.

#### **Free School Meals**

Why should I apply? - For every child that is entitled to free school meals the school receives extra funding to enhance provision and improve progress and outcomes for children. So please apply even if you do not wish to take up your free school meal.

What are the qualifying criteria for Free School Meals? Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.

Infant free school meals in England -Your child will be able to get free school meals if they're in: reception class, year 1, year 2. We still ask that you apply for this via the normal free school meals applications so as to prevent your child's school missing out on additional funding.




## **Holly Berries Class**

This half term our featured author will be Michael Rosen and we will be sharing both his books and performance poetry with the children.





In English we are using the book Zog by Julia Donaldson as our inspiration for writing. So far, the children have written descriptions of Zog. To help your child become more familiar with the story you might like to watch it with them.

In Maths, Year 1 are learning to count, read and write numbers within 10. Year 2 have been looking at place value within 100 and consolidating their knowledge of the value of each digit in 2-digit numbers.
