Holly Leaves have been working hard this week in maths we have been looking at composing and de-composing a whole. We have been using blocks to build and knock down towers made up of 2 3 or 4 parts used square card pieces and square stamps to make stampolines of 3 or 4 parts. We investigated how many parts an octopus had by cutting out all it's different parts and making him whole again.



In PE this term Holly Leaves are working on ball control. We have learnt we need to use our eyes and hands to be able to move the ball where we want it to go. We rolled the ball to our partner and then joined together to make a bigger circle so the ball had to travel further.
