## **Emergency Closure Procedures**

If we need to close the school we will:

- Post the closure on our school website www.littledeanprimary.co.uk
- If possible a member of staff will be on site to advice of the closure.

## **E-Schools Communication app**

We encourage all our parents to download the school app if they have an android or iphone tablet or mobile phone. It works a bit like facebook messenger or whatsapp, where all the emails and text messages sent from school are in one place in your app. The big plus is that you do not have to rely on a mobile signal as the messages use a wi-fi signal.

The app can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play. Search for 'eSchools', log in using 'littledean.eschool.co.uk and then your log in details which have been issued to you. If you can't remember them ask in the school office.

You can also log into eSchools using a laptop or desktop computer, you can check messages and see your child's attendance, we also hope to use this to book future parent's evenings, and in the near future we will be able to stop sending paper copies of letters as you will have them electronically.

## Medicines/Allergies

Staff in schools are advised not to administer medicines to children. However if no alternative is available we will administer medicines on your behalf as long as a medicine form has been completed and the medication is in the correct packaging. Forms are available from the class teachers. If your child has an allergy ie nuts, strawberries please let the class teacher know.

#### **Healthy Snacks**

Children in the Acorns, Holly Leaves and Holly Berries Classes are provided with a free piece of fruit each day for their mid-morning snack. Chestnut and Maple Class children are able to bring a snack into school for their break, but we do ask that it is healthy such as, fruit, veggie snacks, crackers etc. We ask that they do not bring crisps or chocolate bars.
