#### **Learn these facts of by heart**

There are 60 seconds in a minute. There are 60 minutes in an hour. There are 24 hours in a day. There are 7 days in a week. There are 12 months in a year. There are 365 days in a year. There are 366 days in a leap year.

### Number of days in each month

January	31	July	31
February	28/29	August	31
March	31	September	30
April	30	October	31
May	31	November	30
June	30	December	31

#### Questions to ask at home

How many days are in one year?

How many days are in a leap year?

What day comes before February 1st?

What day comes after March 31st?

# Key vocabulary

There are 24 hours in a day

In a **leap year** there is an **extra day in February**.

There are 60 minutes in an hour and 120 minutes in two hours.

# Learn the rhyme:

30 days have September, April, June and November. All the rest have 31.

Excepting February which has 28 days clear and 29 each leap year.
