Guidance from the Agreed Syllabus

In Reception class, children should encounter Christianity and other faiths as part of their growing sense of self, their own community and their place within it.

Three of the above units focus on Christianity, and the others include opportunities to encounter Christians, Hindus, Jews and Muslims, as well as non-religious responses and ways of living.

Six units are provided and schools should teach at least 4 of these.
