Dear Parents/Carers

Residential Visit – Wednesday 27th April – Friday 29th April

With only 6 weeks until the year 5/6 residential, final arrangements are currently being made. The children are excited and I have recently submitted our activity preferences for the trip – we are now waiting for In2Action to confirm our programme of events.

On Wednesday 27th April we will leave school by coach at 10.15 a.m. and return to school on Friday 29th April at approximately 13.10 p.m. Children need to be in school on Wednesday morning at 10.00 a.m. and collected on Friday at 13.30 p.m. They will arrive and leave from the back playground as normal.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch with them for Wednesday lunchtime, they will eat this when they arrive at Grittleton House. A school packed lunch can be ordered instead but we will need to know if this is required by Monday 25th April at the latest.

Valuables such as mobile phones, electronic games, ipads, MP3 players etc. are **not** permitted.

Cameras **are** allowed; however, they are the responsibility of the children – the school cannot take responsibility for lost or damaged cameras. Cameras attached to mobile phones/tablets are **not** permitted. Teaching staff will be taking a lot of photographs throughout the stay which will be shared with the children when we get back to school therefore a camera for the children is not essential.

Spending money may be brought - we suggest a maximum of £10.00 in a named purse/wallet. There is a small shop on site where drinks, ice-creams etc. can be bought.
