Dear Parents/Carers,

It is wonderful to see all the children in school looking so smart and ready to learn. We give a warm welcome to our new children and families who have joined us this year, also to our new teachers, Mrs Walters and Miss Aldred, and Teaching Assistants, Miss Goodall and Mrs Crowell-Hall.

Start and Finish times

We will continue with our 'drop and go' policy and the staggered start and finish to the school day as this has worked very well last year and limited the congestion on the back playground at the start and end of the school day.

The timing for this year are:

Juniors Children (Maple and Chestnut Classes) – arrive for an 8.40 a.m. start, collect at 2.55 p.m.

Infant Children (Holly Leaves and Holly Berries Classes) – arrive for an 8.50 a.m. start, collect at 3.05 p.m.

All children will be expected to be in their classes at the allocated times including siblings, this may mean that you have to wait in the playground for siblings at the start or end of the day.

Please remember that if bringing a car, you are considerate to our neighbours, parking sensibly and not blocking driveways. Thank you.

Cases of Covid 19 and self isolation

Please refer to the letter sent out earlier this week from Gloucestershire County Council regarding Covid-19 update.

If your child is unwell before the start of the school day, please do not bring them into school. Please phone the school office and let a member of staff know exactly what symptoms your child is exhibiting, even if you do not suspect Covid-19. If your child has symptoms: persistent cough, high temperature, loss of sense of taste or smell please arrange a PCR test.

Your help is very much appreciated in helping us to keep our school community Covid safe.

Healthy Snacks / Cool Milk

Please remember that we are a healthy school so ask that healthy snacks are brought into school for break times for children in Chestnut and Maple Classes.

Children in Holly Leaves and Holly Berries Classes will be given a free piece of fruit at break times.

Milk is available for children in reception until their 5th birthday. If your child is over 5 and you would like them to receive milk during morning break time you can register with our cool milk scheme. The cost is approximately £3.00 per term. Further details can be found at [Cool Milk](#)

We ask that children bring a water bottle into school so that they have access to water throughout the day. This should be a separate bottle to the one in their packed lunches unless they are drinking water with their lunch. Children should not be bringing in squash unless this is part of their packed lunch.

Can we ask that all school uniform is labelled with your child's name including shoes, PE kit and Forest Schools clothing. It is extremely difficult to find an owner for a green jumper aged 4-5 when there is a class of children that could possibly own a green jumper in that size. Can children bring in a waterproof coat each day, we do like the children to have as much fresh air as possible even if the weather is a little bit drizzly.
