Lunch

Clothing Requirements

As this is an outdoor adventure day, children should wear practical clothing suitable for physical activity and the weather. Please ensure your child wears:

- Clothes that you are happy for them to get dirty
- A waterproof jacket and waterproof trousers in case of rain
- A sun hat and sun cream if the weather is sunny
- Trainers or walking boots that you do not mind getting dirty
- Long sleeves (required for the archery activity)
- Do not wear jeans or expensive clothing
- No jewellery is permitted. This includes rings, necklaces and earrings.
- Crop tops or short shorts are not permitted, as these are unsuitable for adventure activities. Children wearing these items will not be able to participate.
