#### A Few Reminders...

#### **Absences**

Children should attend school every day that they are well enough to do so. Please see separate leaflet "is my child well enough for school?" Should you decide that your child will not attend school please remember to follow our absence procedure which is to contact the school office by phone on 01594 822171, before 9.15 a.m. An answerphone is available.

We ask that you give a reason for your child being absent. Our safeguarding procedures will be followed if we do not know why your child is absent from school. Please do not email or leave messages on Class Dojo regarding an absence as these may not be checked until later in the day.

#### **School Timings**

- School starts at 8.40 a.m. Gates are locked at 8.45 a.m. If children arrive after this time they must report to the main reception doors for entry into school.
- Lunch for all year groups is now 12.10pm 1.10pm. Snack is 10.45am-11am.
- > School ends at 3.10 p.m. or 4.10 p.m. when attending after school clubs. If you are going to be late or if someone different is due to collect your child, please let us know. Thank you.

#### **School Lunches**



Please remember to complete the School Dinner Menu each week. These are handed out every Friday and will need to be completed and handed in on Monday morning with the meal choices for that week.

If a menu has not been completed and your child doesn't have a packed lunch then we will choose option 1 for them from the menu that day.

Payments are to be made on ParentPay in advance of ordering, otherwise you may be asked to bring in a packed lunch. If you are having any issues with payments, please contact the school office.

You may have seen that we have newly designed reading records. We believe that reading is the key to learning and it is our biggest priority. Not only do we want children to know the importance of being able to read fluently but we want them to experience the enjoyment that books can bring.

#### This term in Chestnut Class...

Chestnut Class have had a great start to the academic year!



We are enjoying the book 'Oliver and the Seawigs' by our focus authors Philip Reeve and Sarah McIntyre.

Our English lessons this term are based on the book 'Lights on Cotton Rock' by David Litchfield. We are currently working on starting our sentences in different ways. Throughout this term we will write part of a story and also a poem.



Maths lessons are focusing on place value of 3 and 4-digit numbers. This includes partitioning, ordering, finding 1/10/100 more and less and plotting numbers on a number line. As well as this, we are working on learning all of our times tables to 12x12.


Free fruit for infants is only for children from Reception to Year 2. Please send in a healthy snack that your child can eat at break time if your child is in Chestnut or Maple classes.




# This week in Maple Class...

Maple Class are well and truly back into the swing of school life! This week we launched our new science topic, *Classifying Big and Small*. The children got stuck in by exploring the Linnaean system of classification and had a go at applying it to the tiger, *Panthera Tigris*.










In English, we've been writing simile poems about pets and family members, with some wonderfully creative comparisons already appearing in their work. In maths, the children have been learning all about Roman Numerals. They can now read and write them up to 3000 – parents, you might want to put their skills to the test!

We've also started our new class reader, *Black Powder* – described as "a rip-roaring historical adventure" and winner of the Young Quills Award. The children are already hooked!



Looking ahead, we're excited about our trip to the Cheltenham Literature Festival in October, where we'll be attending a special workshop led by author James Turner.
