#### **Pre School**

We have a few vacancies in our Pre-School for children who are 3 or 4. Our opening hours are: Monday, Thursday and Friday - 8.45 - 2.45, Tuesday closed all day and Wednesday 8.45 - 1.15.

Nursery funding for 15 hours is available for all children from the first term after their third birthday. The Governments new 30 hour funding is also available for parents who work or those entitled to certain benefits. Alternatively we are able to invoice you for the sessions.
