


Outdoor Learning	Photograph different flowers and name them.	Stick Insect Symmetry Project. 1) Research what makes an insect an insect? What are the main parts? You may need to look at photographs of insects (internet). 2) Gather sticks and create a symmetrical stick insect. 3) Photograph your artwork and stick in your homework book or send them to the class email address at the foot of this page. 4) Label the different parts of the insect. Science	Design a quiz related to our science topic (refer to the knowledge organiser).			
Maths	Stick Logic Collect 9 sticks/twigs approximately the same length. How many triangles is it possible to make using 9 sticks/twigs? Investigate. Label the types of triangles you have made (equilateral, scalene, isosceles) Possible ways to present your findings: 1) Photograph and stick in your homework book or email to the class email address. 2) Sketch your designs into your homework book			  Examples of Giuseppe Arcimboldo
Creativity (art/design)	Create close observational drawings of different plants/flowers.	Design a quiz related to our portraits art topic (refer to the knowledge organiser).	Create a self-portrait in the style of Giuseppe Arcimboldo . You could use real fruit and vegetables and photograph your portrait or use drawings of fruit and vegetables. The choice is yours.	
English	Write a set of humorous instructions. For example: How to annoy your older brother/sister/grandparents/parents... <i>Only complete this task once we have analysed instruction texts in English lessons first to ensure you include all the relevant features of the text type.</i>	Learn a poem to perform to the class. Think carefully about your use of voice - pace (speed), volume (loud, quiet), clarity, good intonation, facial expressions and actions. Ways to present to the class: 1) Video your performance at home, send to the class email and we will watch in class; 2) Voice record your performance at home, send to the class email and we will listen in class; 3) Perform in person in front of the class.		
Topical	#GBBO Design and bake a cake based on the theme animals. Present using photographs or bring the cake in to share with your year group.	Read one of the 100 books to read before the end of year 6 and write a review - how many stars out of 5 would you give it? Who would you recommend it to? See the review sheet on the class webpage.	Create a PowerPoint about something that interests you (football team; hobby; pop group; favourite book). Maybe include a short quiz at the end.
