Residential Visit April 2022

Unfortunately, our residential provider In2Action have advised us that they are no longer able to offer residential visits at Whitemead Park in Parkend.

They have however offered us an alternative setting for our residential visit keeping the same dates as before, arriving on Wednesday 27th April, leaving Friday 29th April 2022, and they have also honoured the price.

The new setting is Grittleton House which is in Chippenham Wiltshire SN14 6AP. It is approximately 45 – 60 minute drive from the school. They say:




Accommodation Details



The main Victorian manor house comprises of 26 bedrooms sleeping up to 150 children in spacious dormitories of 4-10. Children stay in either bunk or single beds. These rooms are split over 2 floors with schools assigned their own accommodation section within the main building. Each school has their own separate boys and girls bathrooms.

Each school section has multiple lockable teacher bedrooms and separate bathrooms for teachers. Teacher bedrooms are predominately single rooms or on occasion twin. (This would be dependent on your group size)



Nightime can be a daunting time for children away from home, particularly if this is for the first time. Therefore our number one priority is to ensure all children staying at Grittleton House feel safe and secure during their time with us, and that all teachers have the required support that they need from the In2action team to ensure this is achieved. A member of our In2action team is on call 24 hours a day, plus our staff will be on duty till 11pm at night to support you at bed time if needed. There is CCTV coverage and coded doors into the main building.

Staff Lounge

The Staff lounge is located on the first floor of the main house and is equipped with comfortable chairs and kitchen factilies. This provides the perfect location for teachers to relax at the end of each day.

The student lounge can be used by all schools in the down time between activities, along with our games room which includes table tennis and pool.



The Restuarants

At Grittleton House we have 2 restuarants we use. The first is on the ground floor of the main house and is used for breakfast and lunch.

The second restaurant we use is found in a building in the grounds, The Old Stables. These converted Victorian Stables are located on the edge of the estate under the old clock tower, leading on from a central cobbled courtyard. This restaurant has a capacity for approx 100 children and is used for the evening meal.







All meals are prepared on site and we can cater for almost all dietary requirements.
