Attendance will be monitored daily, weekly and termly, we will be contacting you if attendance falls below expected standards. The Governors Attendance policy states that the expectation is that every children on roll should attend every day when school is in session, as long as they are fit and healthy enough to do so. The Governing Board have set a whole school attendance target of 96.5%.
