Dear Parents,

We welcome you back to school for Term 2, already we have been thrown a curveball as England enters a 2nd national lockdown with schools remaining open as normal.

We would like to thank you for wearing face coverings on the school site and helping us to keep the school community as safe as possible. We also ask that you take the approach of 'drop and go' or 'collect and go' when bringing and collecting children from school. If this is not possible please ensure that you socially distance in the rear playground, steps and slopes to and from school and in Oak Way carpark. Please help us to keep our children, staff and school community as safe as possible.

We will continue with our staggered start and finish times, please help us by keeping to the class timetable or agreed sibling times.

Unfortunately due to medical conditions Mrs Tattersall and Mrs Bonser have been advised to shield so will be unable to work in school throughout this lockdown. So as to reduce the impact on the children and teaching staff other teaching assistants have agreed to work additional hours, should you have any concerns please do not hesitate to contact us.

Illness and Attendance at School

While we would like every child to attend school every day we know that it is sometimes not possible. Children are often unwell with general coughs, colds, sore throats, etc and the best place for them is at home when they are unwell

This year we also have Covid-19 to deal with. The symptoms of Covid-19 are:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

If your child or a member of your household suffer from these symptoms then we must follow the governments guidance. Currently this is to isolate for 14 days and to arrange a Covid-19 test. If your child is unwell before the start of the school day, please do not bring them into school. Please telephone the school office and let a member of staff know exactly what symptoms your child is exhibiting, even if you do not suspect Covid-19. If your child becomes ill during the school day, we ask that you come and pick them up as soon as possible. Please remember to use the rear entrance of the school at all times. Thank you.

Free School Meals

Why should you apply?

For every child that is entitled to free school meals the school receives extra funding to enhance provision and improve progress and outcomes for children. So please apply even if you do not wish to take up your free school meal.

What are the qualifying criteria for Free School Meals?

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income
 of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Children who get paid these benefits directly, instead of through a parent or guardian, can also get free school meals.

If you feel that you may be entitled to free school meals you can check your eligibility and apply for meals by visiting: https://www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/education-and-learning/school-transport-and-free-school-meals/ All applications will be treated in confidence.

Starting School as a reception child in September 2021

If you have a child that is due to start school in September 2021 an application pack should be sent to you during November. If you do not receive an application pack please contact the school admissions team on 01452 425407 or email school.admissions@gloucestershire.gov.uk. The deadline for completing your choices is 15th January 2021.
