

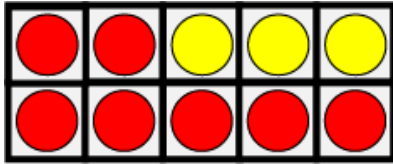
# KIRF: Number Bonds To 10



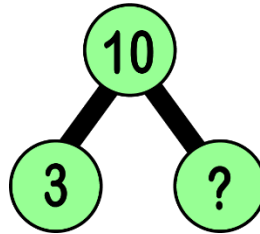
Number bonds show us how numbers join together. They are very important for addition and subtraction. Pupils should be able to recall these independently.

## What can this look like?

Concrete:

Abstract:

7 and 3 make 10

$$7 + 3 = 10$$

$$10 - 2 = 8$$

### Questions to ask at home

What do we need to **add** to 7 to make 10?

If I have 4, how many more do I need to get to 10?

What is the **difference** between 10 and 1?

### Key vocabulary

2 **add** 8 equals 10

8 **plus** 2 is the same as 10

10 **take away** 7 equals 3

10 **subtract** 3 makes 7

10 **minus** 9 equals 1

### Things to try

**Everyday Objects:** Gather together 10 objects and separate them in many different ways as possible, write the calculation to match each one.

**Chants:** Practice chanting the number bonds.
