Complaints about Parking / Supervision of children in Oak Way Car Park

Once again we have received complaints about parents not being considerate when they park cars during drop off and collection. This has been from residents of Oak Way who have had cars and garages blocked in, and parents being abusive when asked politely not to do this.

Oak Way car park belongs to Two Rivers Housing Association and there has been a long standing informal agreement that parents can use the car park for a quick drop and go, as long as they do not interfere with the resident's use of this area. Two Rivers Housing Association have the right to block access to non-residents.

So that our parents do not lose the privilege of being able to park in Oak Way car park we ask that everyone is considerate to our neighbours and not block entrances, cars and garages. Also to remember that it is a quick drop / collect and go and not a place to leave your car while visiting the play park, friends, etc.

Shoes

We ask that children do not wear open toed sandals or sliders into school, it is not safe for them when they are running around in the playground. Shoes or trainers are ideal.

We don't mind what is donated, colour, size, shape, as we plan for this paper to be used as scrap paper, drawing paper, making paper aeroplanes etc.
