School Communication

Jewellery in School

We have noticed that a number of children have been wearing jewellery. A reminder that children will be asked to remove items such as earrings, rings, watches etc. for PE/swimming to prevent any injuries (earrings in particular are prone to being torn from earlobes when contact is made). If ear piercings have occurred within the last 6 weeks, children will be asked to apply micropore tape. Thank you for helping us keep your children safe.

Thank you for your kind donations for our bags to school clothing collection. We made £86.85 for the school funds. Our next collection will be in February 2020.

Flu Immunisations

These will take place on Friday 25th October 2019 for all children in years reception through to year 6. If you would like your child to receive the nasal vaccination and have not already returned the consent form please do before Thursday 24th October. Further consent forms are available on the school website or from the school office.

Clothing in School

We have a large amount of uniform in our lost property bin which we are unable to return to children because they are not named. If you child has lost an item of clothing please check our lost property bin which is located in the School Library – Thank you.

We ask that all items of uniform, PE kit, bags and coats are **named** so that we can return items to the correct child if they lose them.

We suggest for all classes including pre-school that PE kit (trainers, shorts, t-shirt) are brought into school at the start of each term and kept in school in the cloakrooms.

Pre-School children will need a PE kit each day as their sessions will change weekly. Pre-School staff also request that wellies are brought into school so that they can play in the garden with the mud kitchen. Thank you.

We ask that children also bring a weather appropriate coat into school as we will go outside most days during lunch and break times.
